- Steering Committee
- Role of Cluster Faculty Panels
- Approach to the Development of Guaranteed Transfer Pathways
  - Learning Outcomes or Courses
  - Regional and Statewide
- Ohio Mathematics Initiative (Quantitative Reasoning, Statistics, and STEM Pathways)



- Eight Clusters

Phase I: Business; Social and Behavioral Sciences and Human Services

Phase II: Education; Arts, Humanities, Communication, History, and Design; STEM

Phase III: Public Safety, Health Sciences, Industry/Manufacturing and Construction

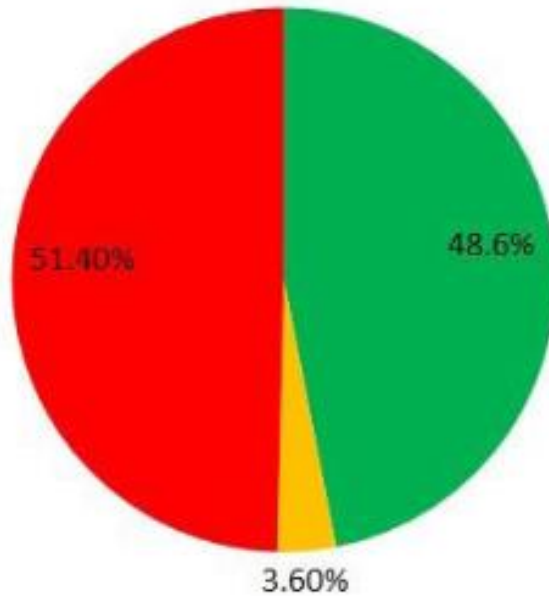
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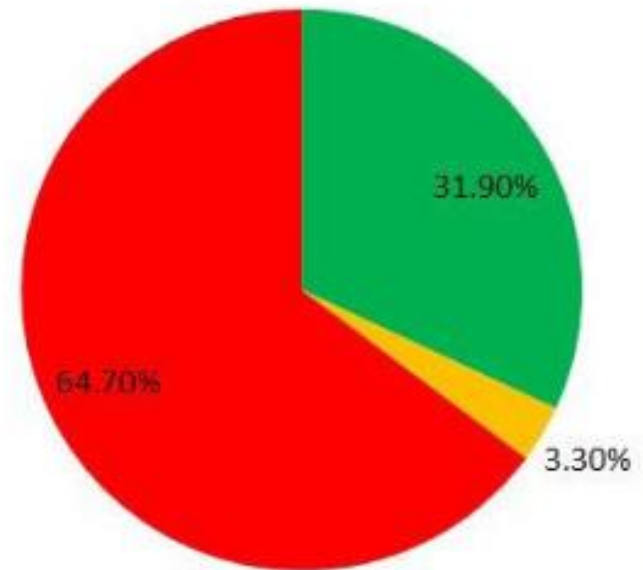

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# MTAGs

- 125 unique courses
- 176 matches to TAG courses
- 59 matches to CTAG courses
- Currently 15<sup>th</sup> place out of 36 for TAG numbers (volume)



# May Outreach Campaign

- May was military appreciation month
- Targeted messages each Monday of the month
- Asked institutions and vet offices to “share” via social media
- Used as a trial run for potential future outreach



# Nursing / METC Project

- Sent 2 faculty members to METC to look at military medic curriculum
- Held meeting on May 19<sup>th</sup>
- Interested in pursuing 3 paths for military medics
  - EMT to Para to RN, ADN to RN to BSN, Medic to BSN
- Forming groups to start this work



# General Education (GE) Credit Project

- Project to pursue utilizing military pre-deployment training to potentially meet multicultural-global diversity type GE requirements
- Led by Brad Myers (Retired OSU Registrar)
  - Research Training
  - Research Documentation
  - Make Recommendations to public institutions



# NVEST Report From SVA

- <http://nvest.studentveterans.org/> (SVA, NSC, VA)
- Some Highlights of the Research
  - 72% success rate
  - 347,564 students earned 453,508 certificates/degrees
  - Business, Health, & Liberal Arts are top 3 majors (STEM is #2)
  - 16-18% of armed forces is women
    - 23% of certificates/degrees are women
